mild day I was busy cutting fire wood  
Frank cut fire wood in the  
back very mild this evening

Thursday 21

Snowing all day wind blowing  
from west very mild Frank  
hauling fire wood the wind  
shifted to north this evening but  
still snowing and very mild  
a plane arrived from Ft Nelson

Friday 22

20 above low this morning fine all day  
McLeod brought around from  
Ft Nelson this evening Frank  
got the mail very cloudy toward  
evening

Saturday 23

Blowing a very strong north wind  
with snow all day very little  
doing Bill McLeod arrived from  
Ft Nelson and was taken to the  
Hospital very sick the Colonel came  
toward evening and turned cold  
23 below at 10 o'clock
