A fine clear day. Dunsam started to plow this morning. I was helping him to start. Fred went to Dawson Creek. I drove over to the H. B. store for a few supplies after dinner. Very hot all day.

Friday 9

to Treaty paid the Indians at Fish Creek a few skins. also arrived Dunsam plowed half of today. Very warm all day.

Saturday 10

My birth day 72 years old today. A fine clear day. Fred lost the mail. The Buley came for a visit.

Sunday 11

A fine warm day. I drove down to the top of the Hill and I mowed up the window of the house.
