Cold and stormy this morning with snow Wind from North Mrs & Mr Slyman left for home afternoon the Yukon train passed on its way South about 11 AM Frank sawing fire wood fine and clear to night 25 below Z

Friday 28

Cold and stormy and continued all day Frank went to the Lake for a load of wood left by about 10 AM and around the place 30 below to night
