a number of Indians as well
at the trial. Willie arrived by the
Mail Plain from Prince George
& got home about 11 P.M. to night

Wednesday 9

A little milder today Duncan
left this morning with Friday team
to Mackay for some furs at Slyman's
Frank & Willie went for
the mail

Thursday 10

10 below this morning and
very mild about noon Duncan
left this morning for Keg Creek
with dogs a plain left going south
Frank at Wood
12 below to night
